Luke 7:36-38

- Repentance
- Humility

- Gratitude

Outrageous rudeness

Luke 7:39-47

- I look down on others
- I think highly of myself
Romans 12:3
- I deserve Gods favor
- I become numb to needs

Outrageous love

Luke 7:48-50

- ➔ Jesus receives worship which only God deserves
- ➔ Jesus has the ability and willingness to forgive
- ➔ Jesus pays the highest price to forgive

Luke 7:36-50

Exploring the Scriptures

1. Simon the Pharisee judged the woman to be a sinner and rejected her, expecting Jesus to do the same (Luke 7:39). Instead, Jesus accepted her and didn't mind her touch. Read Matthew 8:1-3 and 9:20-22 for other instances of Jesus' dealings with "unclean" people. He states his position on the subject in Matthew 15:16-20. How does this apply to Simon and the woman?

2. Jesus knew who the woman was, but forgave her because of her faith (Luke 7:50). Simon didn't think he needed forgiveness. Recall Jesus' words in Luke 6:37-38. How did Simon measure up to these and how do you measure up?

3. In Jesus' parable (Luke 7:41-42), he implied that both Simon and the woman were bankrupt before God. Write down some of the debts that God has forgiven you. Do you love him more as a result of his mercy?

4. The woman knew that she was forgiven because Jesus told her so (Luke 7:48). The Bible says the same thing to us (see Isaiah 1:18-19, 43:25 and Acts 13:38-39). Ask yourself, do I accept this, or am I still trying to earn forgiveness? Read Ephesians 2:8-9.

5. Read Matthew 18:21-35, where Jesus told a parable similar to the one we looked at this weekend. What principles and insights about forgiveness do you see there? Write down what you think it means to "forgive as the Lord has forgiven you" (Col. 3:12-13).
