KEY WORD: Authority

- In His message **Luke 4:31**

- Over demons **Luke 4:33-37,41**
Colossians 2:15

- Over sickness **Luke 4:38--40**

Growth Group Homework

Week 6 of 6

For the week of June 12, 2011
Luke 4:31-44

Quick Review: Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there a particular point, verse or comment that caught your attention, challenged you or raised a question?

Connecting Questions

1. Jesus went to a solitary place to recharge after a full day (Luke 4:42). Do you have a special place where you can take a break from pressure? What do you do there?

2. Jesus impressed people because he spoke with confidence and power. Was there a teacher or mentor in your past who helped shape your character or career?

Exploring the Scriptures

1. Unlike the rabbis, who argued endlessly over tiny points of the law, Jesus taught with authority (Luke 4:32). How do people view authority today? In your daily life, how much do you rely on God's Word versus all the other influences?

2. The Bible teaches about the clash of two kingdoms, God's and Satan's. Read Galatians 5:19-26. What are some characteristics of each kingdom?

Is everybody subject to one kingdom or the other, or is there a middle ground?

3. In dramatic moments, demons spoke through people and announced publicly for the first time that Jesus was the Son of God (Luke 4:34, 41). Why did he silence them, and how does this relate to his time of temptation by Satan in the wilderness?

4. Our battle against evil is a spiritual one and requires spiritual weapons. Read Ephesians 6:10-18. Share a few thoughts from this passage regarding the resources available to us so we can win these battles.

5. Over the past 6 weeks of this series, we have seen Jesus announced, baptized, tempted, praised, rejected and demonstrating supernatural power. What stands out most in your mind from your group discussions, either specific insights about Jesus or areas of personal growth?
