Luke 5:1-11

Exploring the Scriptures

1. Standing beyond the crowd that was hanging on Jesus' words, the rough, exhausted guys busy washing their fishing nets might have seemed the least likely candidates for disciples. What insight does that give you about predicting who will be receptive to the gospel?

2. After the disciples' hopes were dashed by the crucifixion of their Master, Peter and others went back to fishing. Compare Luke 5:4-10 with John 21:1-19. How does this help you understand the persistence of God's calling in your own life?

3. List the sequence in convincing Peter to leave everything and follow Jesus. (See also John 1:33-42.) How would you react in each of these steps? Take some time and ask God what plans he has for you.

4. As with Peter, recognizing and responding to God's call will always involve making decisions. Good decision making is built upon three important foundations: Scripture, wise counsel, and the inner promptings of the Holy Spirit. Below are some verses that shed additional light on each of these components. Read them and write down your insights.
