# Growth Group Homework

For the week of May 29th, 2011

Luke 3:21-4:14

**Quick Review:** Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there a particular point, verse or comment that caught your attention, challenged you or raised a question?

## Connecting Questions

1. In our culture, everybody has an opinion. Jesus drew his answers from Scripture. Do you have a favorite verse that strengthens you or guides your life?

2. Jesus was descended from King David. Briefly, what is your family history?

## Exploring the Scriptures

1. Baptizing Jews was highly unusual. Why did John baptize (Mark 3:11)? Why did Jesus want to be baptized (Matthew 3:13-15)? What is the meaning of our baptism as Christians? (Matthew 3:11-17, John 1:29-34, Acts 19:1-5)

2. Jesus prayed at his baptism (Luke 3:21), another indication of his humanness and dependence on the Father. What are some of the other key times when he prayed (see Luke 5:16, 6:11-12, 9:27-30 and 22:41-42)? What is it that stirs you to pray? Worship, confession, gratitude, or requests? (here is a simple acrostic to help you remember those 4 kinds of prayer ACTS adoration, confession, thanksgiving, supplication)

3. Throughout the section we are studying, Jesus was filled with the Holy Spirit. What does that say about how we should live if we expect to conquer temptation? What are some specific ways we can remain in the Spirit?

4. What natural desires are being used in the three temptations? Although the goals were good, why would it have been wrong for Jesus to satisfy each desire in the way Satan offered? How would these actions have affected his ministry and mission?

5. Read Galatians 6:1-5. What principles does it give for dealing with our own temptations and helping others with theirs? What does God say about the times we fall (1John 2:1-2)?

6. When Jesus is being tempted the devil quotes scripture from psalm 91:11-12. Go and read all of Psalm 91. Take notice of verse 10 and 13-16. When the whole psalm is taken into consideration, how does it change the temptation that the devil is giving?
