## **Growth Group Discussion**

For the week of January 22, 2012

Luke 14:1-14

### **Review**

1. What point or comment from this week's teaching caught your attention, challenged you or raised a question?

### **Connect**

1. When attending an event, do you get there early to pick your seat, or just take whatever is available?

2. How do you feel when people do something for you and you can't repay them?

### **Explore**

1. Once again, in Luke 14:1-6, Jesus confronts the religious leaders with the question of healing on the Sabbath. Why was this so important for him and us?

2. Jockeying for position is a universal phenomenon in social situations, but has no place in God's kingdom. What do the following verses say about what our true goals should be: Proverbs 16:19, Matthew 23:11 and Galatians 6:14.

3. What are the three areas in this week's lesson where the Pharisees were wrong? What is the right response in these areas? (See 1 Peter 1:22, Micah 6:8 and Isaiah 58:10.)

4. In Luke 14:12-14, Jesus contrasts those who exchange dinner invitations with each other versus those who give without expecting a return. What do Proverbs 11:25 & 25:21, Luke 6:38 and Romans 12:8 tell you about how we should deal with others?

5. The level of our humility and willingness to put others first is often revealed in how we respond to those who are unappealing. How does Romans 12:9-16 help us better understand what godly humility means?
