Growth Group Homework

For the week of October 9, 2011

Luke 10:1-24

Quick Review: Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there a particular point, verse or comment that caught your attention, challenged you or raised a question?

Connecting Questions

1. When missionaries knock on your door, what is your response (hide, say No Thanks, engage in discussion, etc.)?

2. Have you ever stayed with a family while traveling? In what ways did they make you feel comfortable or uncomfortable?

Exploring the Scriptures

1. As Christians, how are we like lambs among wolves? Workers in the harvest field? Ambassadors?

2. In Luke 10:5-6, Jesus tells his disciples to leave his peace in a house that accepts his gospel. Read Luke 2:14, John 14:27 and Ephesians 2:13-14. What is God's peace and how can you leave it with someone else?

3. Sometimes when the gospel is fresh, as in Tyre and Sidon (see Luke 10:13-15), people are more receptive. When they've heard it many times, as in Capernaum, people may become complacent. What are some ways we can keep this from happening in our own lives?

4. Jesus said that his followers' names are written in heaven (Luke 10:20). Read Revelation 20:11-15. What two facts do you find there about the Book of Life? What should that mean to us, and how does it motivate our ministry?

5. According to Luke 10:21, wisdom is revealed to the humble, not the learned. Read 1 Corinthians 1:18-21, 2:6-7 and James 1:5. How can we best make our knowledge glorify God without building spiritual pride?

6. In Luke 10:16 and 22, Jesus states that he has the Father's full authority. In John 5:26-27, 10:30 and 14:8-10 he goes further. What are some insights you can draw from these verses?
